Obit: 80, of Madison, TN, passed away peacefully on June 16, 2020 at Alive Hospice in Nashville, TN. He was born on January 22, 1940, in Old Hickory, TN. He was the son of George L. and Birda (Malone) Woodall.

He attended Madison High School and continued his education at Belmont University in Nashville, TN, graduating with a Bachelor of Science and Education Degree while spending his time on the Belmont Bruins baseball team. Following graduation, Charles taught with Metro Nashville Public Schools for 34 years, starting his career at Bordeaux Elementary School and ultimately spending 31 years teaching at Highland Heights Middle School. Outside of his classroom at Highland Heights, Charles gave his time coaching football, basketball, wrestling, and track.
