Obit: age 67 of Nashville, passed away peacefully on March 22, 2015.

Mr. Hooks was a graduate of Madison High School and the University of Tennessee where he received a Bachelor of Science degree. He faithfully served his country as a

Corporal in the United States Marines Corps and was awarded many honors and certifications. After his time in the service, he started a 43 year career with the State of Tennessee Department of Revenue and ultimately held the position of Director of Tax Enforcement.
