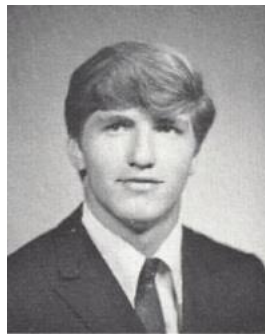

Obit: 65, of Madison, Tennessee passed away Tuesday, November 19, 2019 at his home. Jackie was born January 1, 1954 in Madison, Tennessee to the late Lloyd McCrary and Sara “Betty” Cammuse McCrary.

Jackie was a supervisor for Odom’s Tennessee Pride for 31 years, and Wei Chan’s for 12 years. He was also a farmer raising cattle and taking care of almost everyone’s hay on Neely’s Bend.
