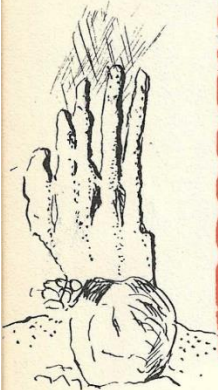




FOREWORD

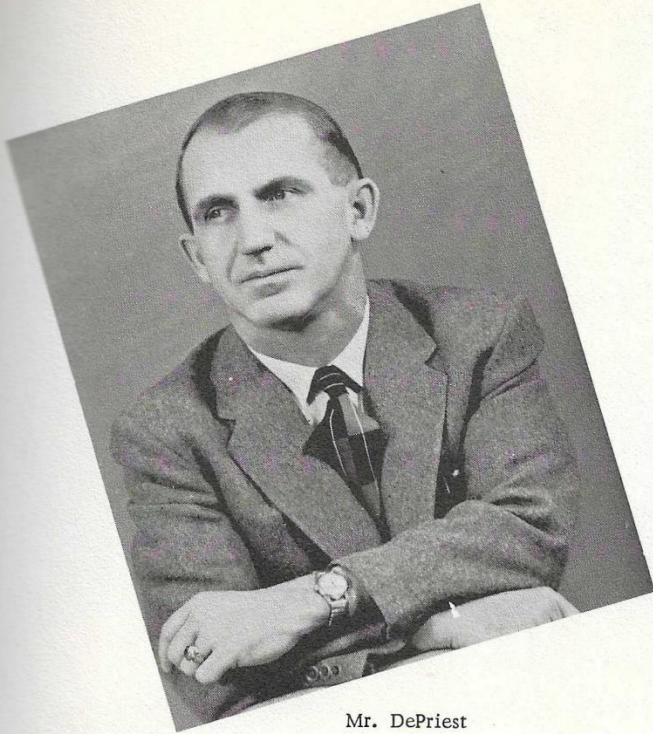
