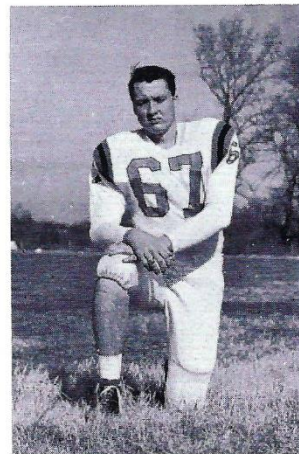

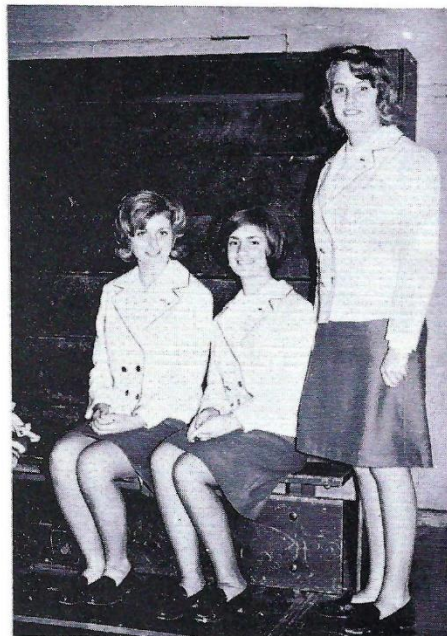
GIRLS VARSITY BASKETBALL

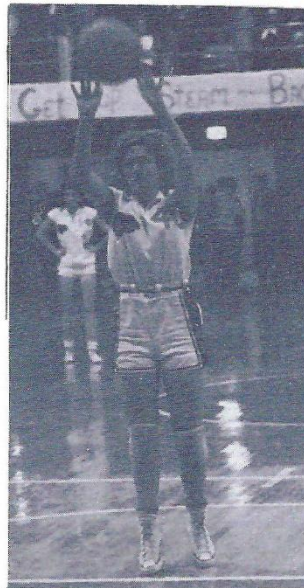

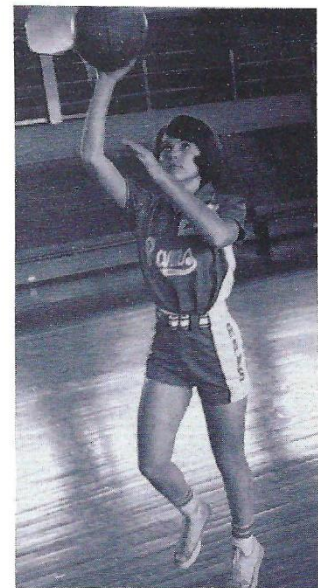

ASSEMBLIES

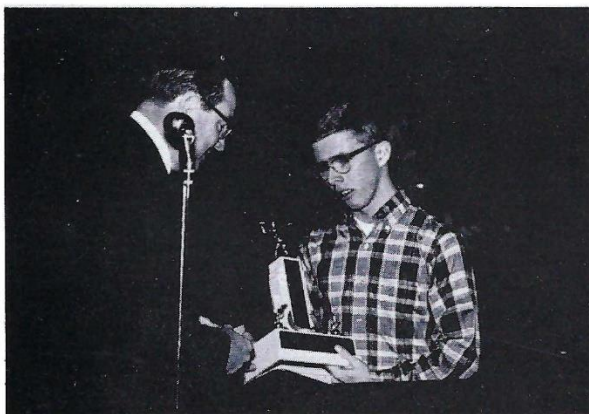

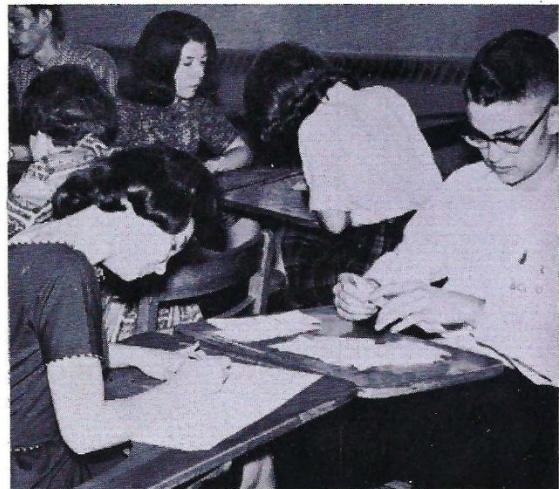

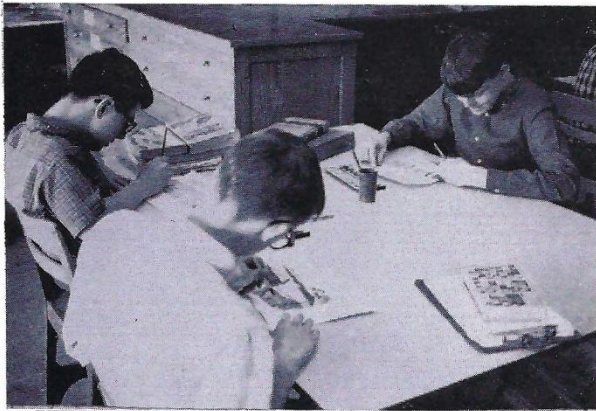
