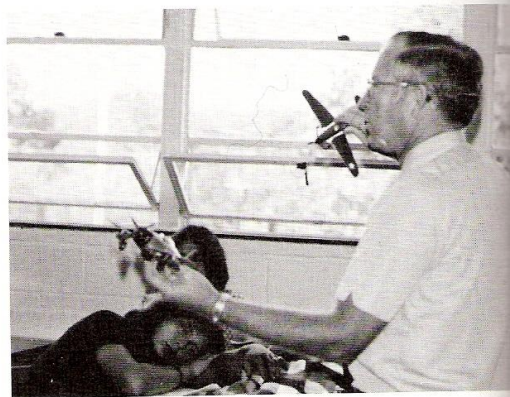
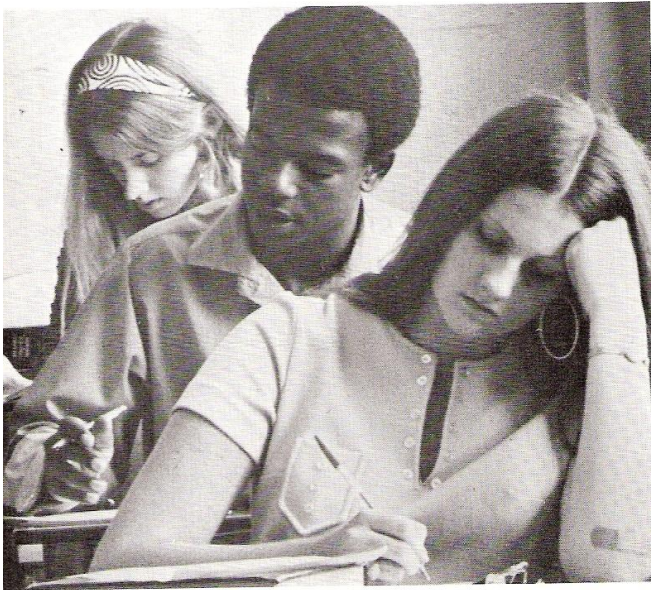
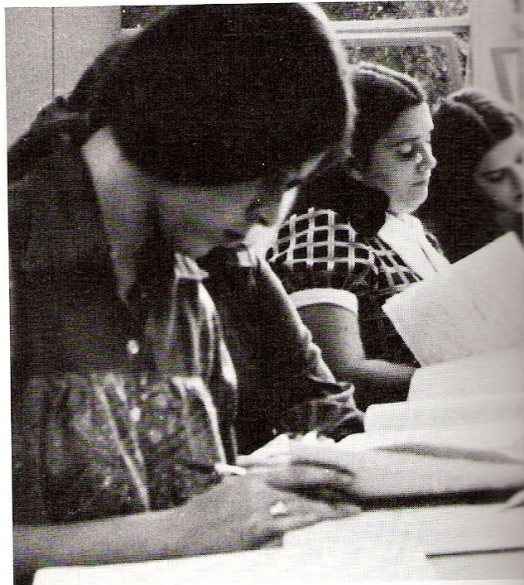
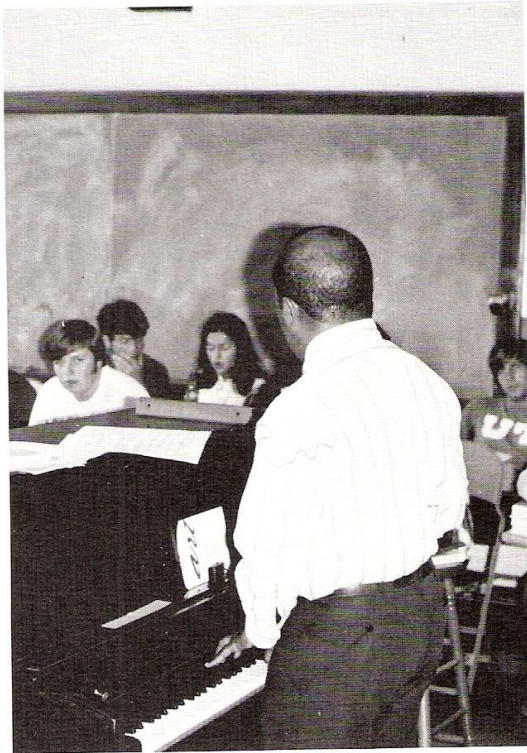


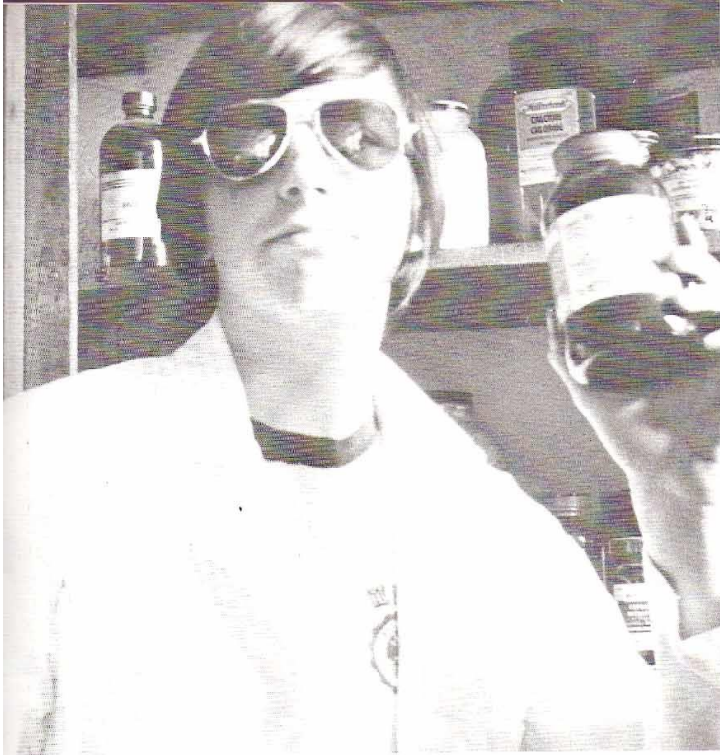


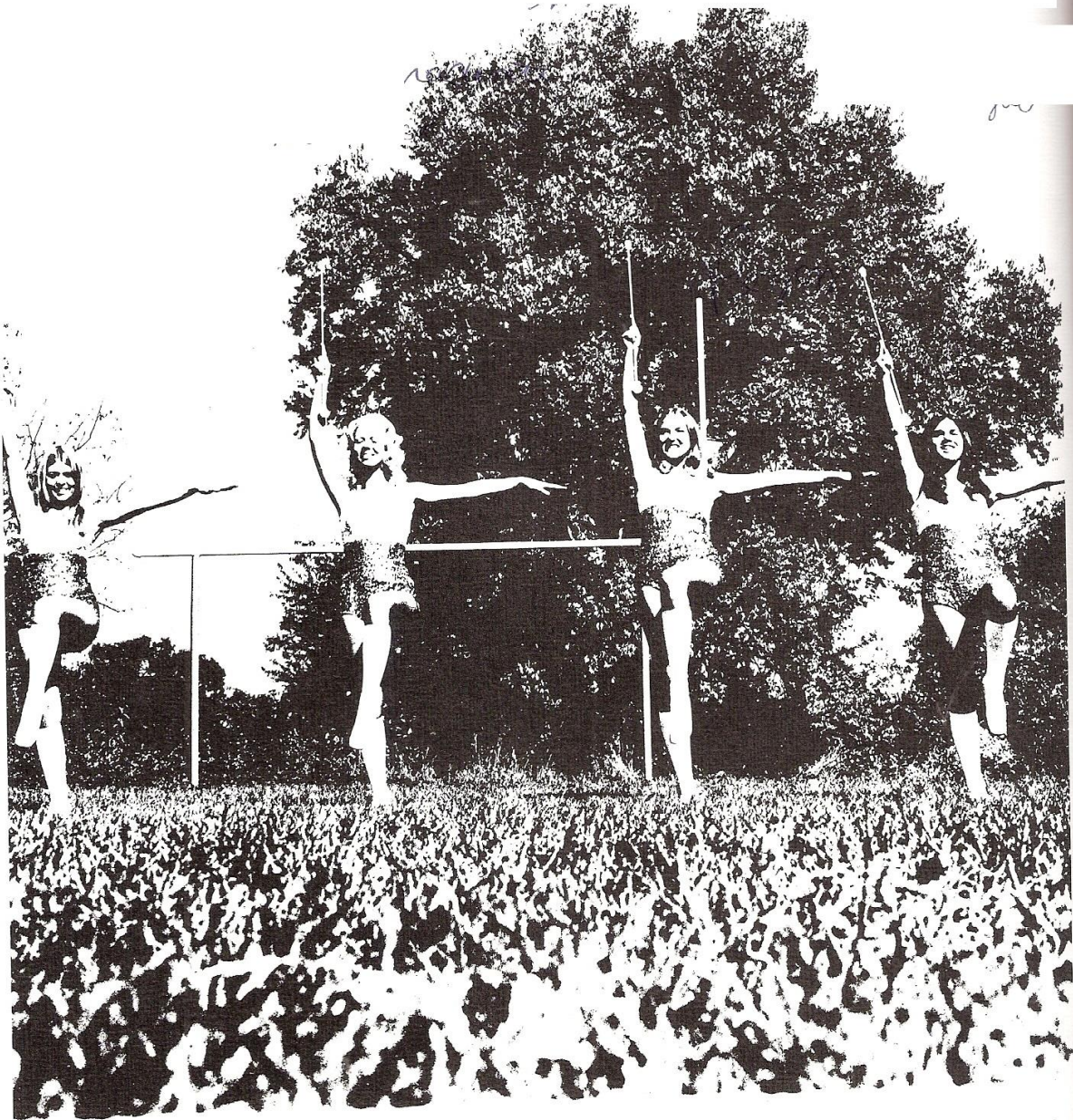


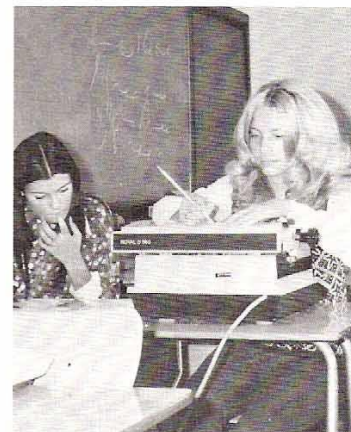
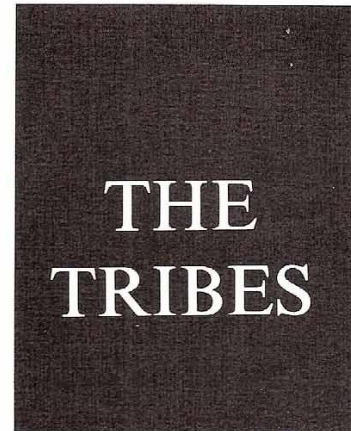
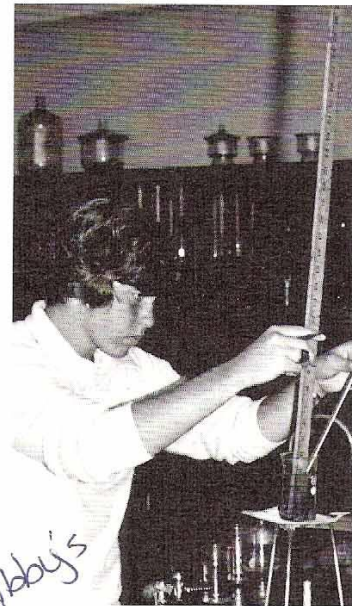












## Exam Exemption Gained Thru

The '72-'73 RAM Staff spent many hard hours on the annual this year to make it the best in Madison's history.

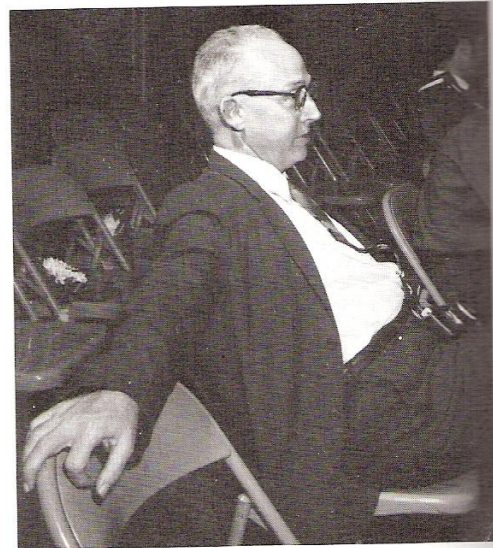
With encouragement from Mr. Byrom, the sponsor, the staff worked on layouts and copy trying to meet the deadlines.

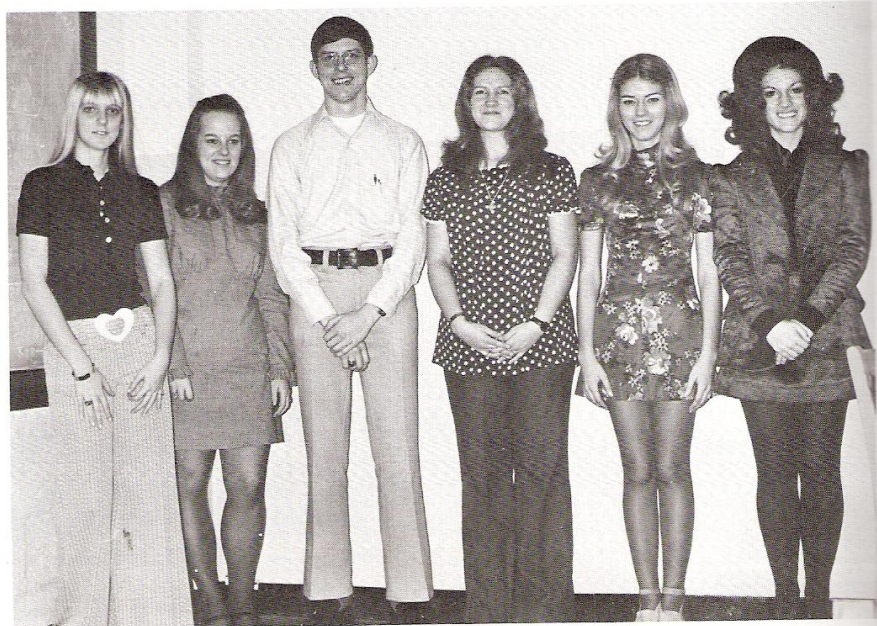

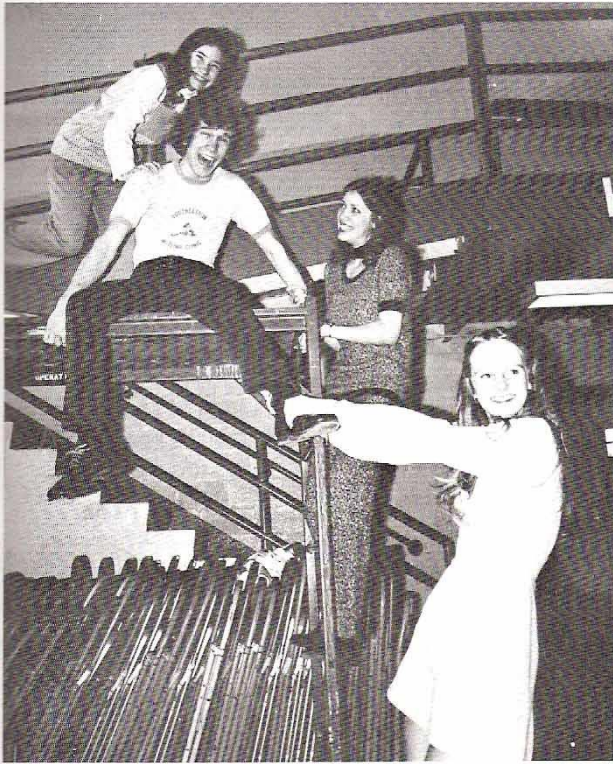

The year 1956 is a time to remember for Madison High School as this is the year the National Forensic League granted the club charter. In seven years it grew to receive all leading chapter award in 1964, and is in line for a second. Beginning with 10 charter members it has since swelled its ranks to fifty plus, meriting the rank of largest chapter in Tennessee and seventeenth in the nation. It is not only the largest and fastest growing, but also very proud of having the Top Student in Tennessee as well as many years ranking in the Top Ten in the Nation out of more than 350,000 plus NFL members.

The chapter excels not only in quantity but in quality. In the past sixteen years they have earned thirty-one state championships.

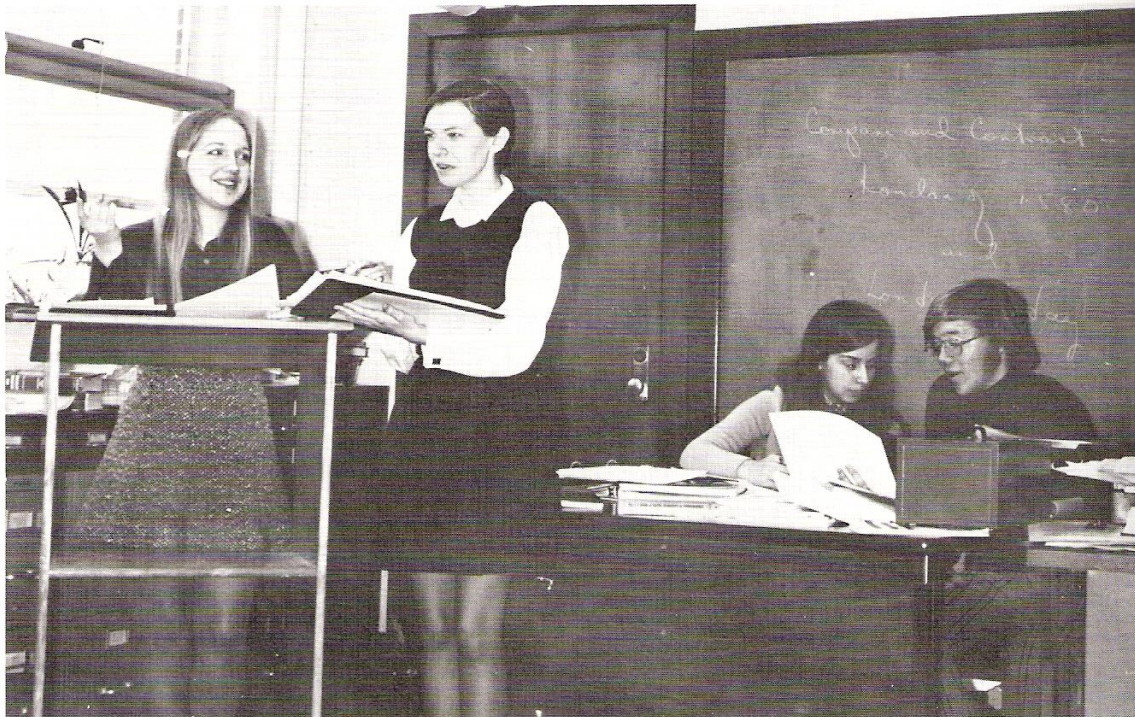

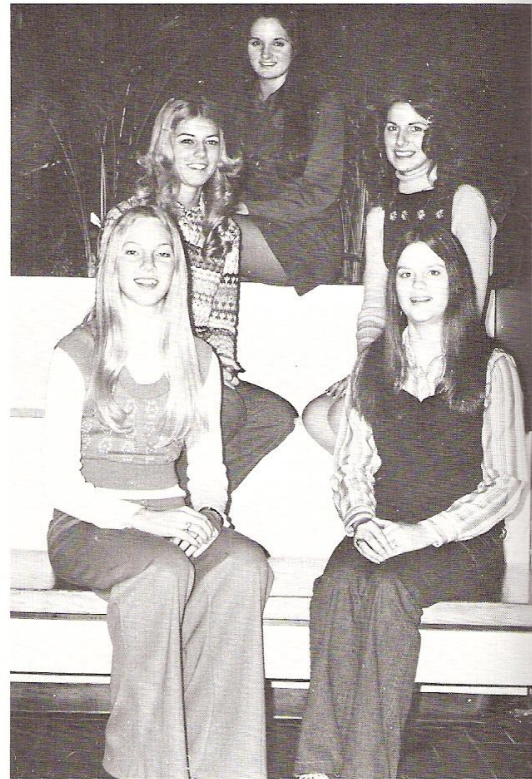
## Civinettes Perform Services for Community

The Civinette Club is sponsored by the local Civitan Club to give the girls at M.H.S. an opportunity to be of service to the community.

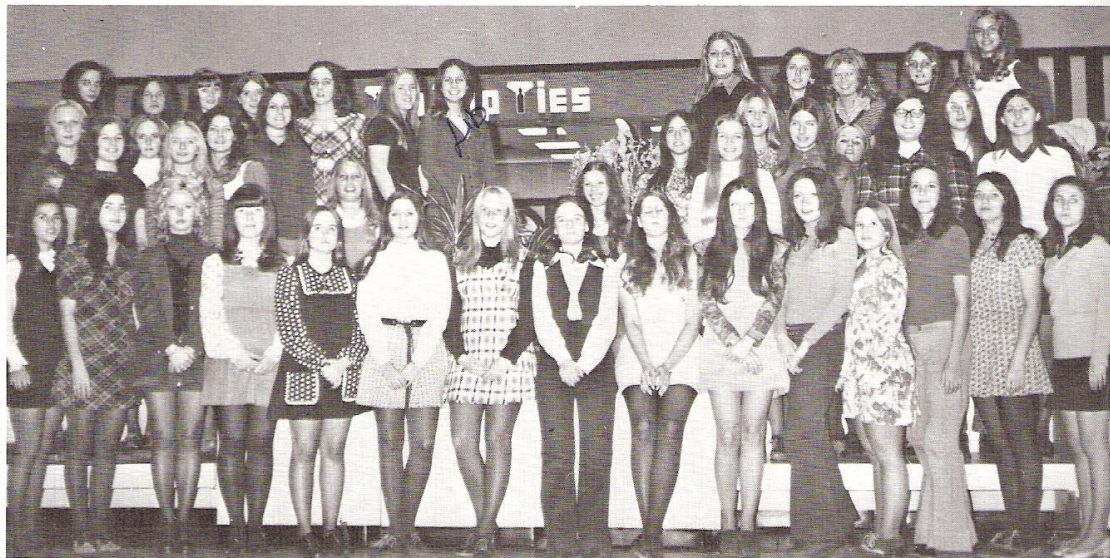

The club sponsored a Christmas tree sale this year with the Madison Kiwanas Club. They also painted Key Club trash cans to be placed on the school grounds.



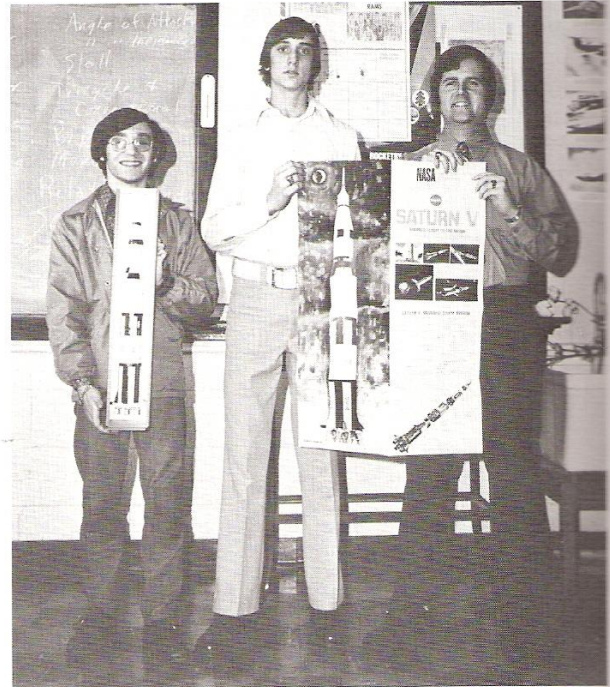

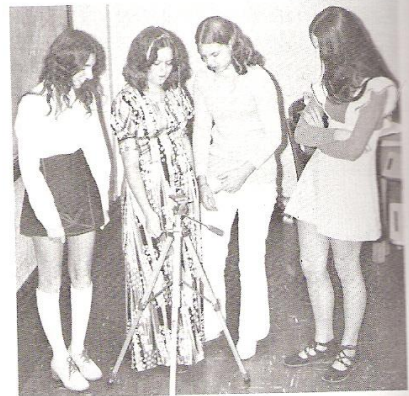

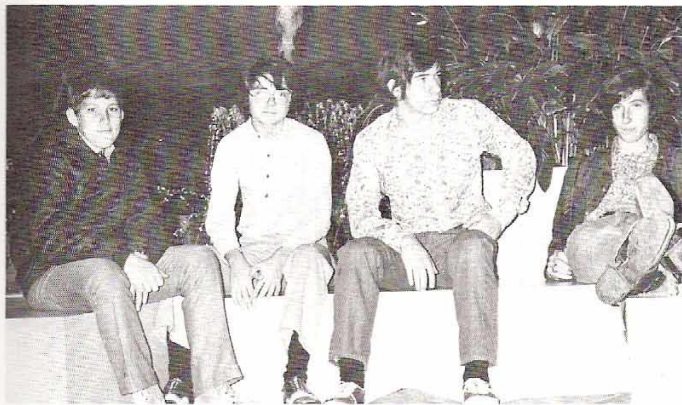

At the meetings they examine coins to determine which ones are of value. Several times during the year they sponsor shows to exhibit their coins.

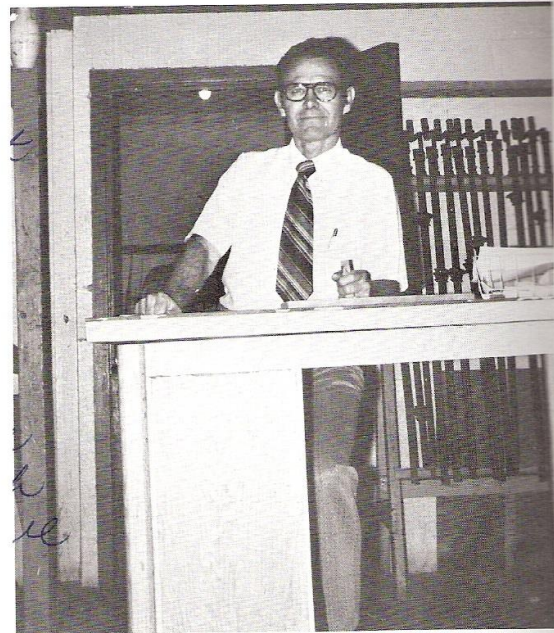

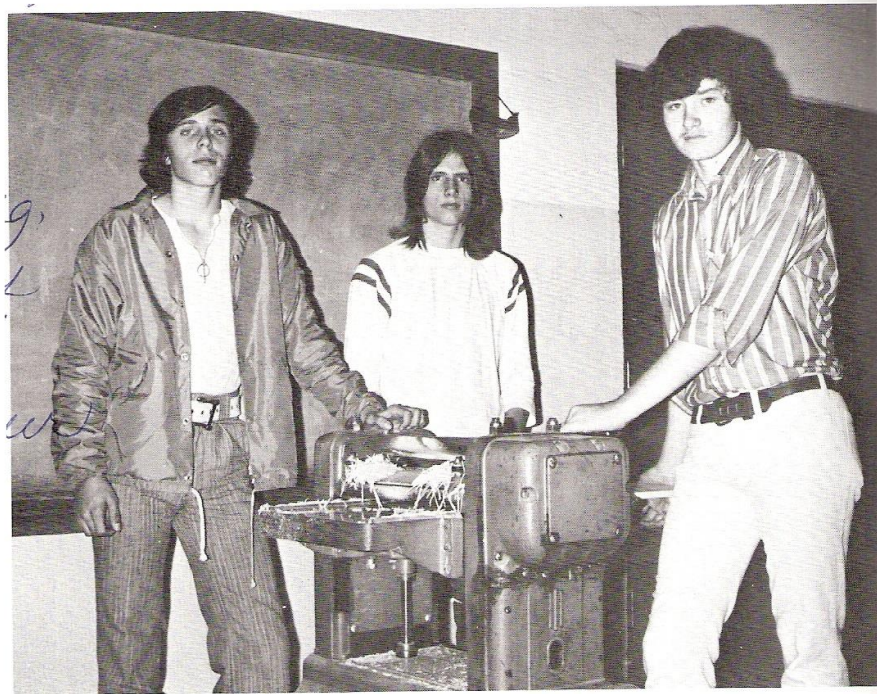
## Woodcarving Club Develops Talents With Wood

Members are taught the safe and proper way to use hand and power tools and learn new techniques in working with wood.

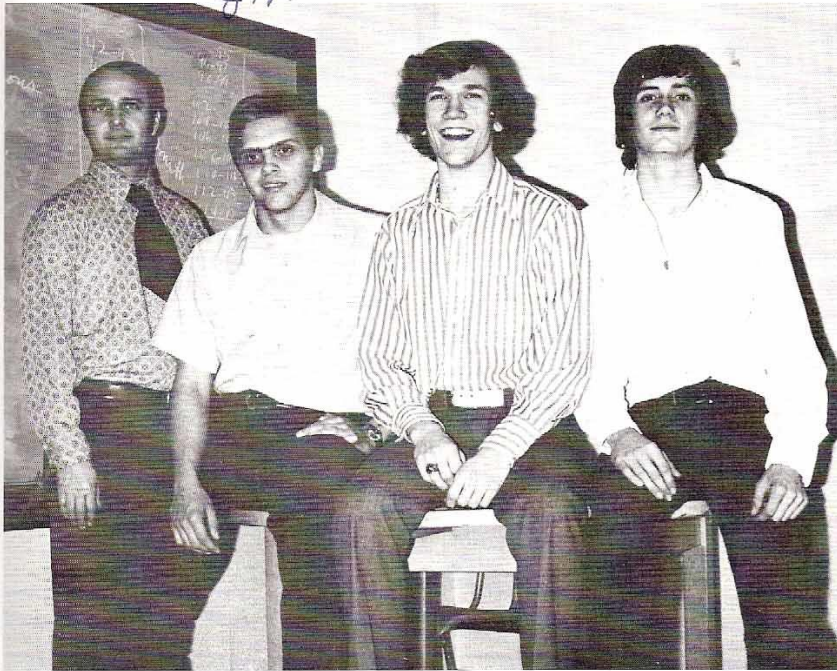

The band members worked many long hours and sponsored projects such as candy sales and a road block to secure funds for a trip to Disney World, where the band was invited to play during spring vacation.

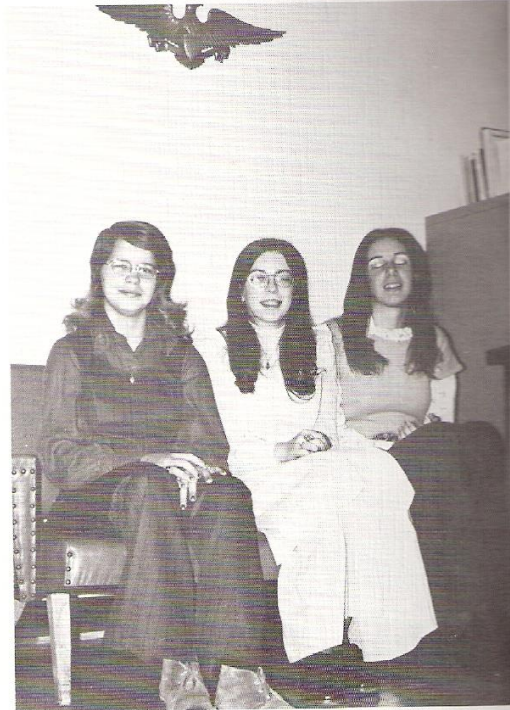

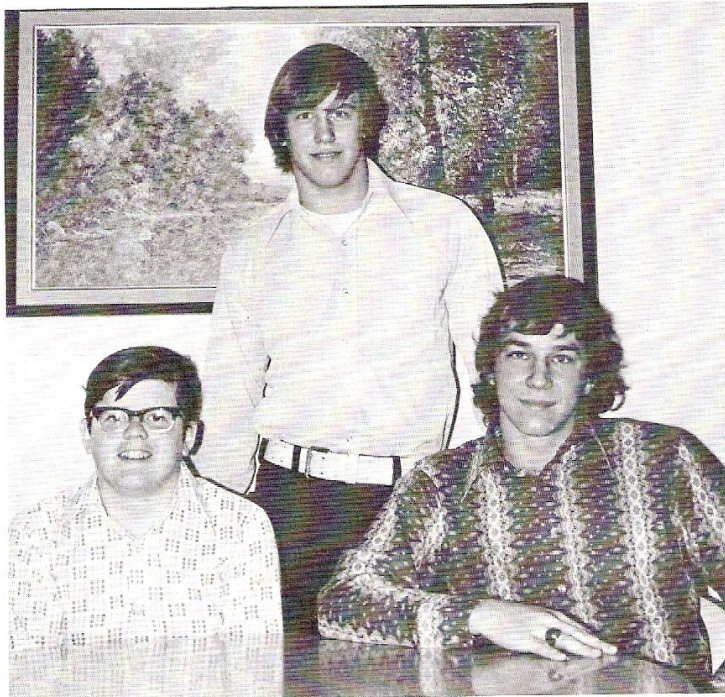
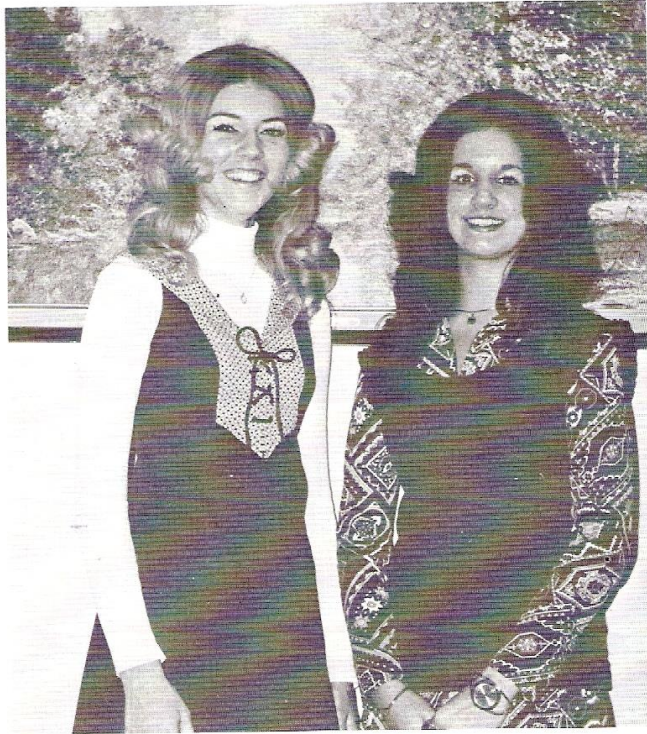
Last summer the student council sent Tyra Burton and Terri Woosley to Girls' State to give them an opportunity to see how state government operates.

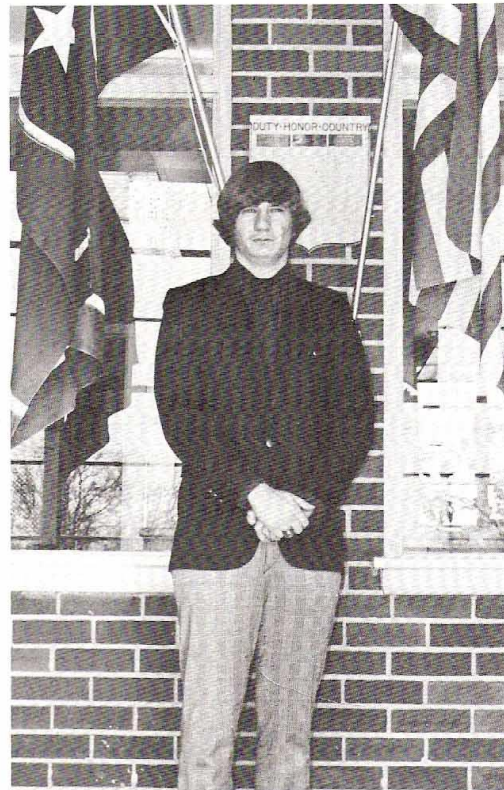
Outstanding in leadership and dependability, Steve Meador was chosen to receive the Civitan Medal, one of the highest awards presented to a senior.

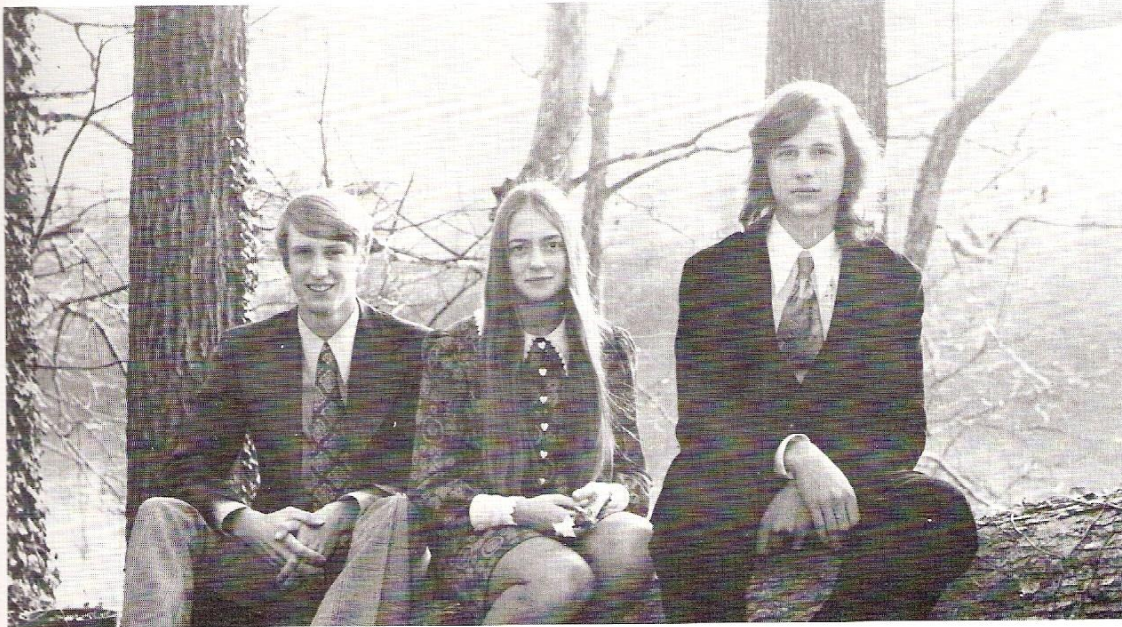
## Class of '74 The Middle Men

A time to love, and a time to oppose that which is wrong; a time to defend freedom, and a time for peace on Earth.

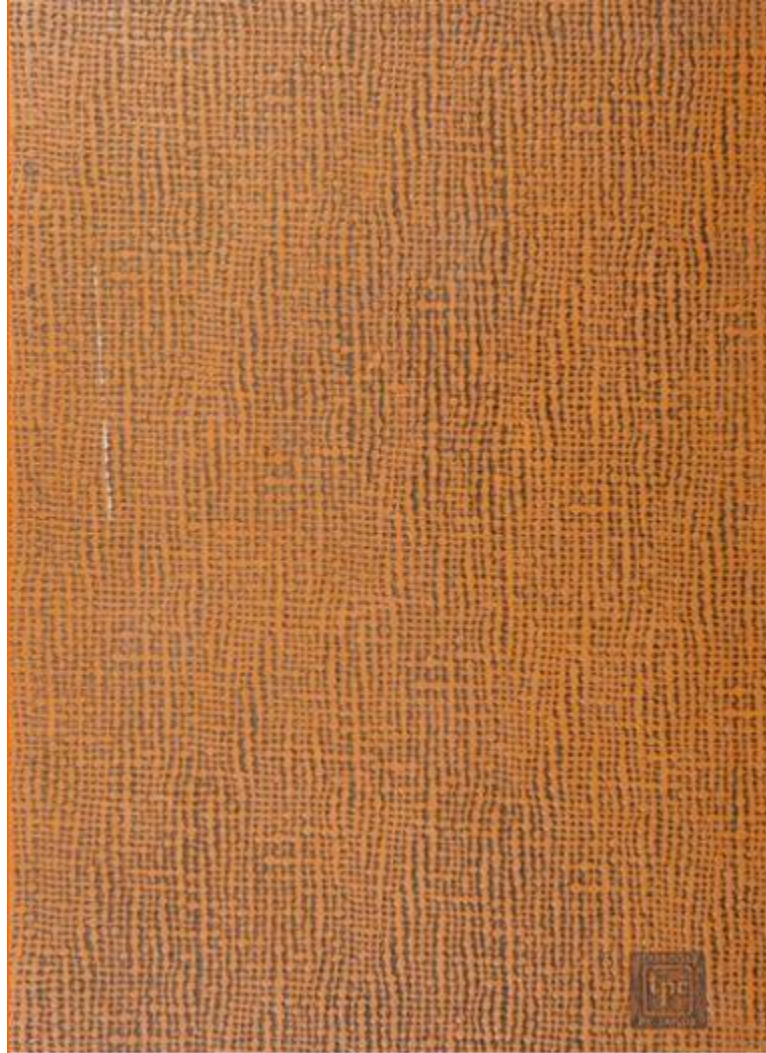
