The triamph, that brought the Rams up to par, was the homecoming game with Cohn. The Rams were fired up by the pup tally, earlier in the day,












As for the cert of the seam, Johnny Warren averaged 39.5. Boh Sloan had a 41 average and David Cantrell, a 40 average.




