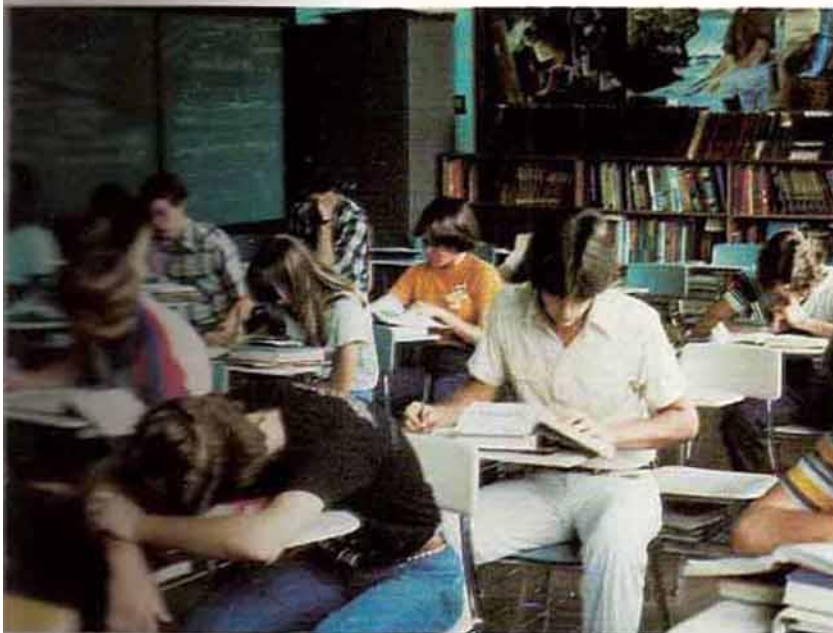

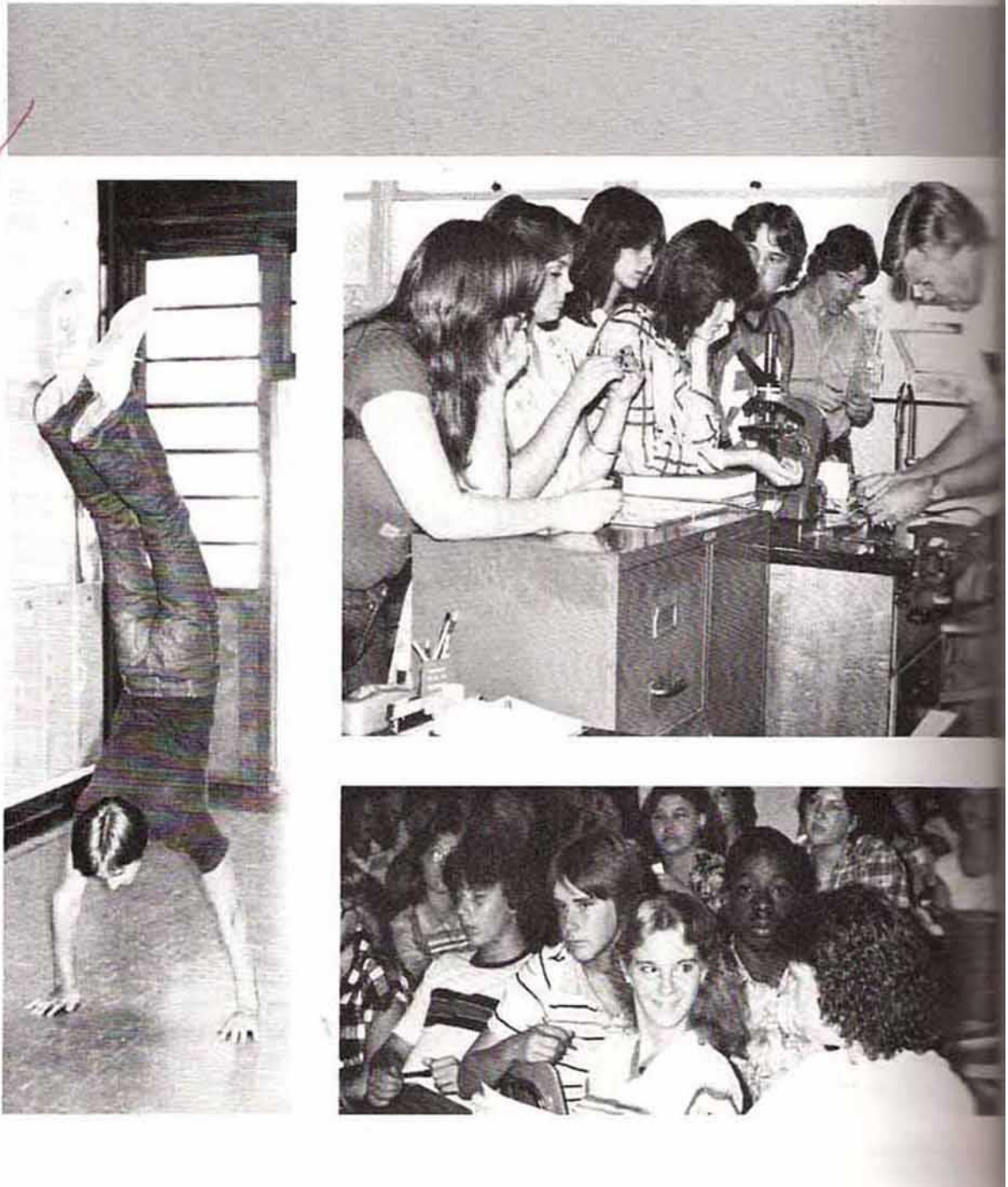


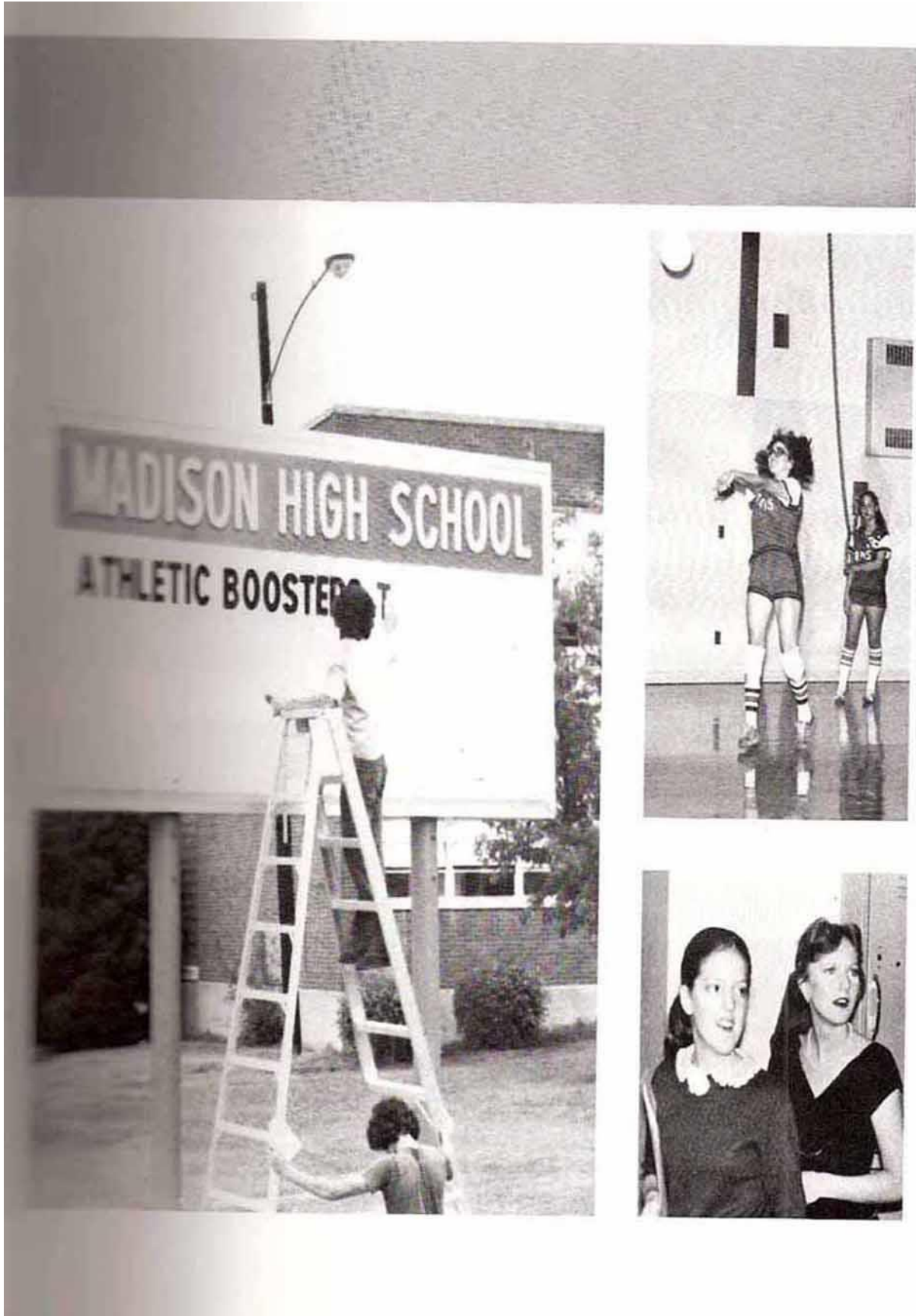

Reflections of Our Lives

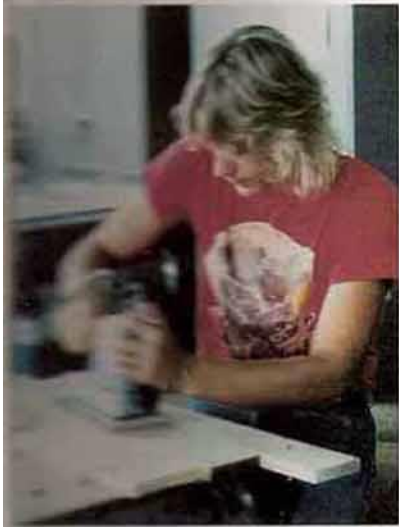
The thought was that it would never end,

We go our own way, and your chance has gone by.

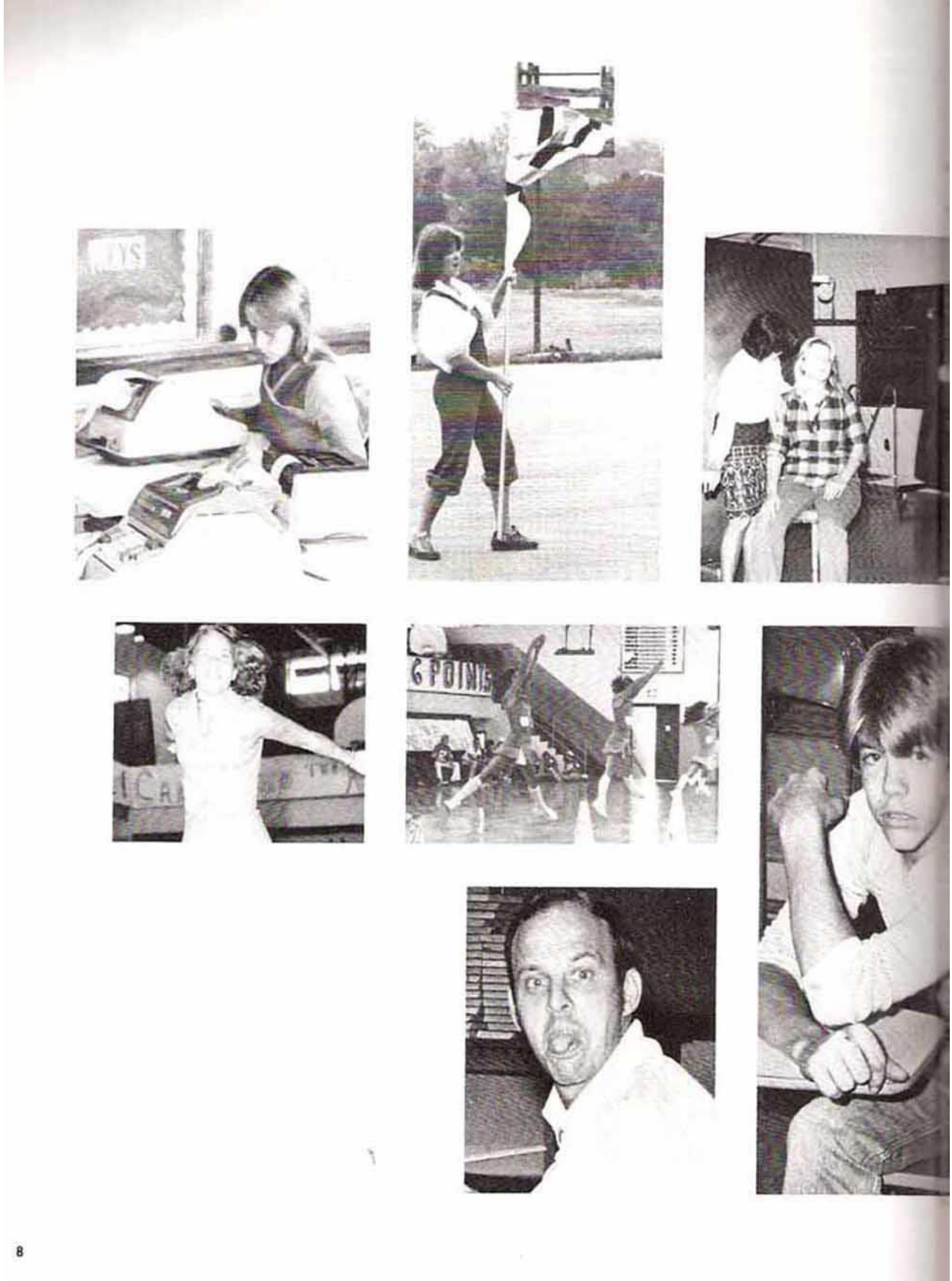
As we leave, our love will stay.

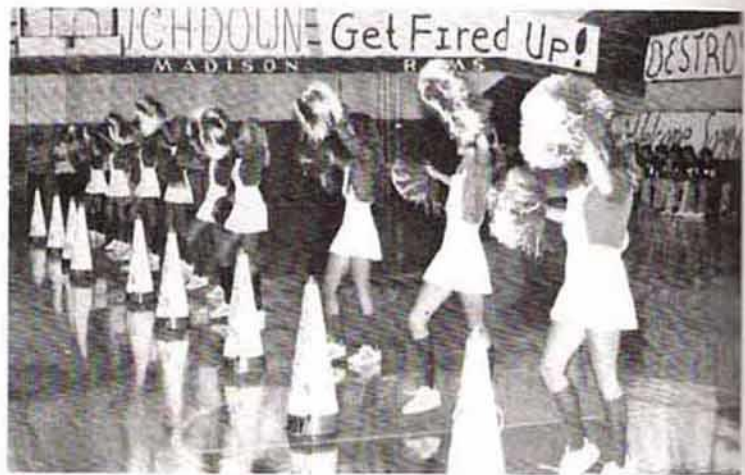

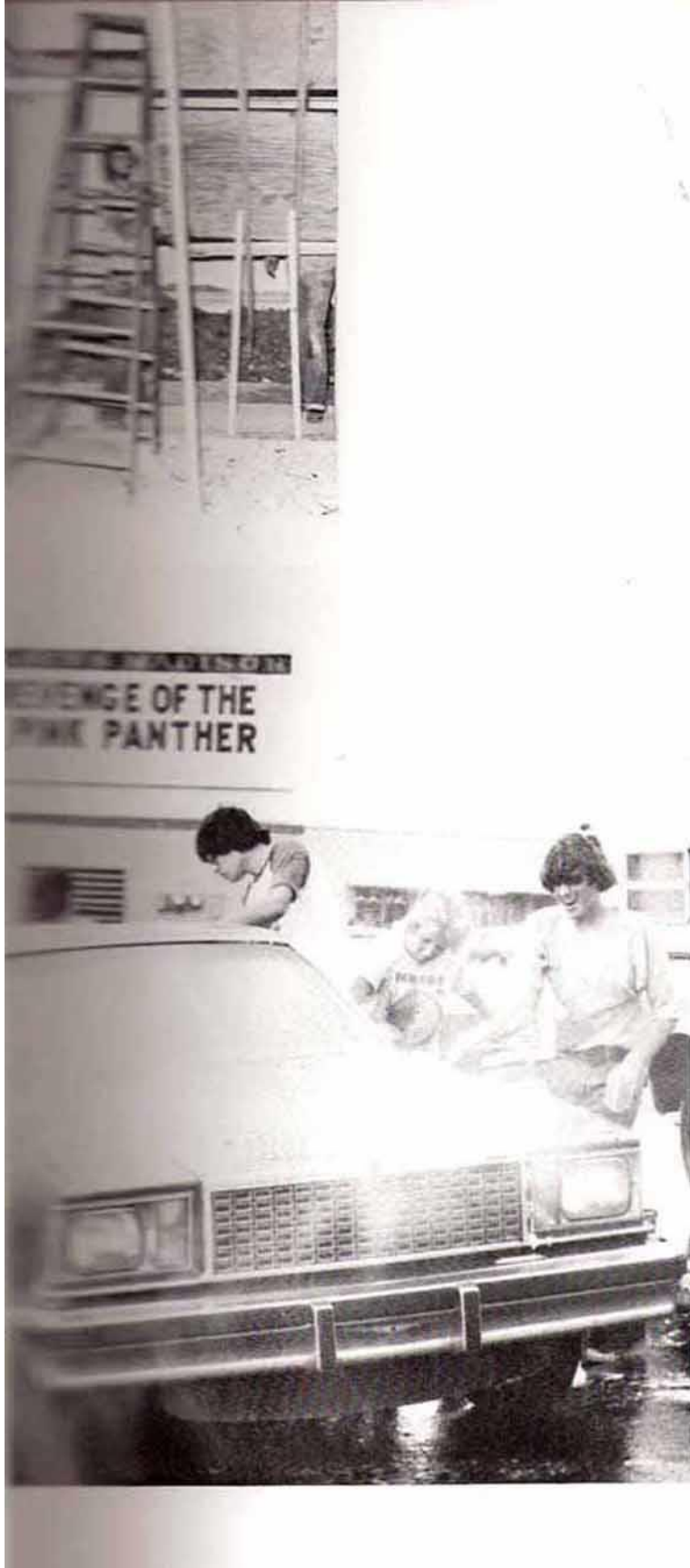


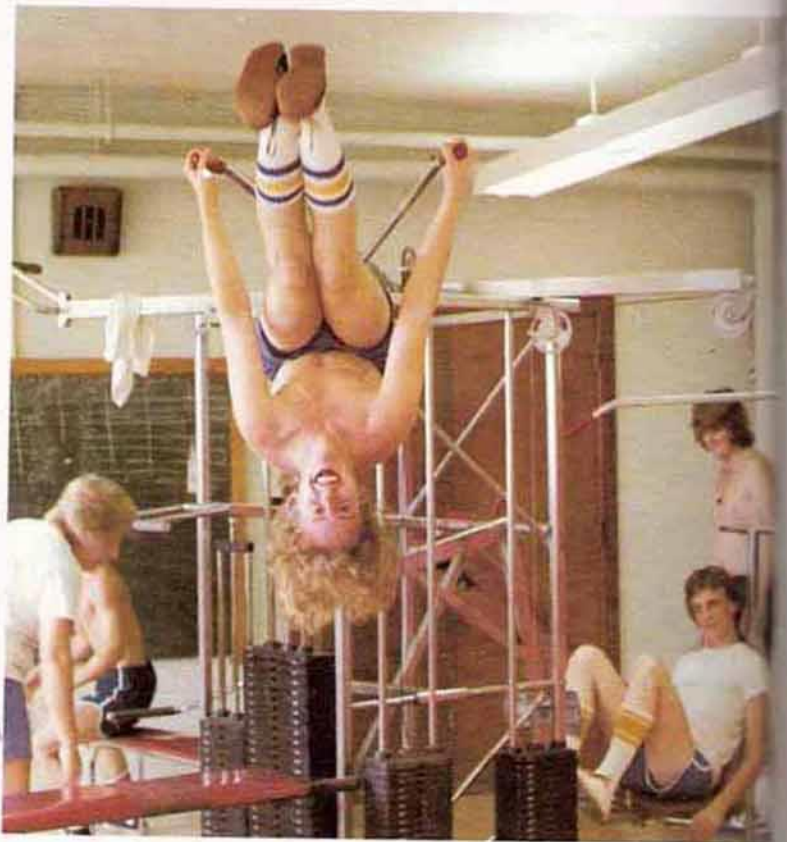


Reflections of: Madison's Changes for '78

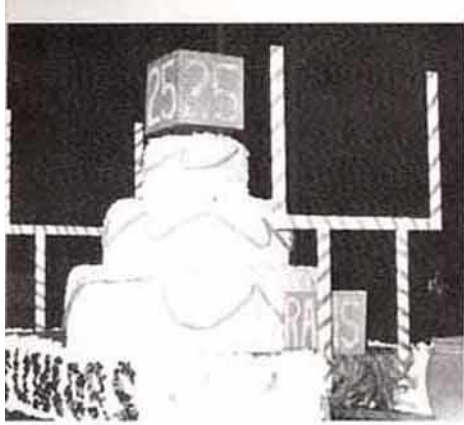

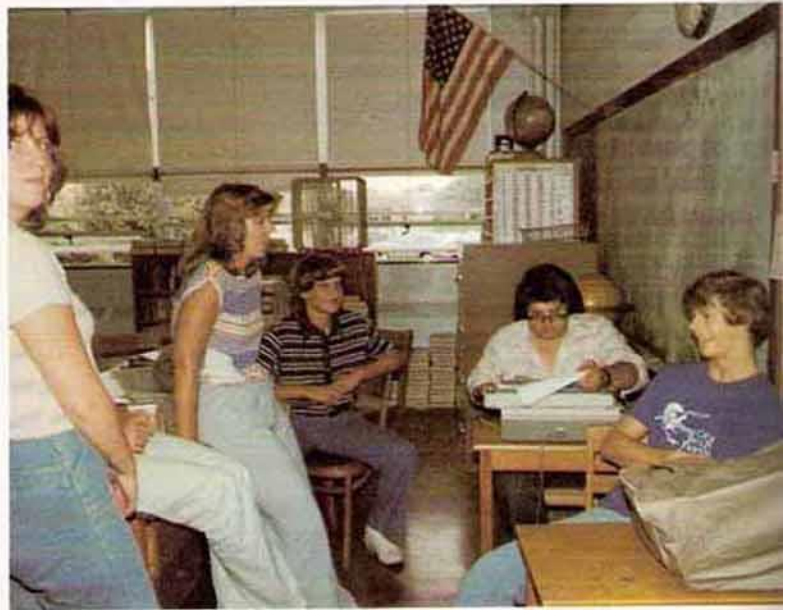




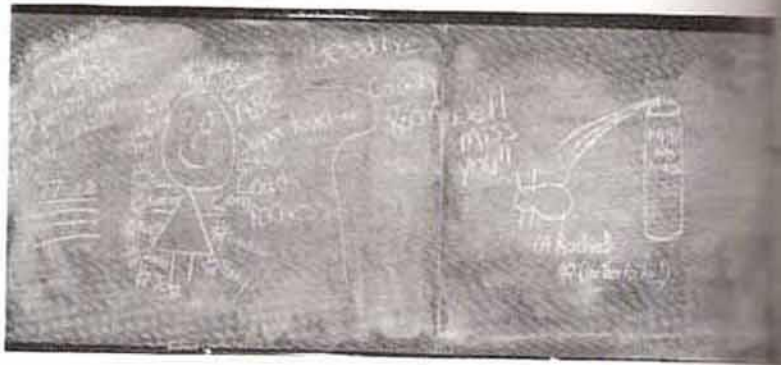
Reflections of: MHS Spirit

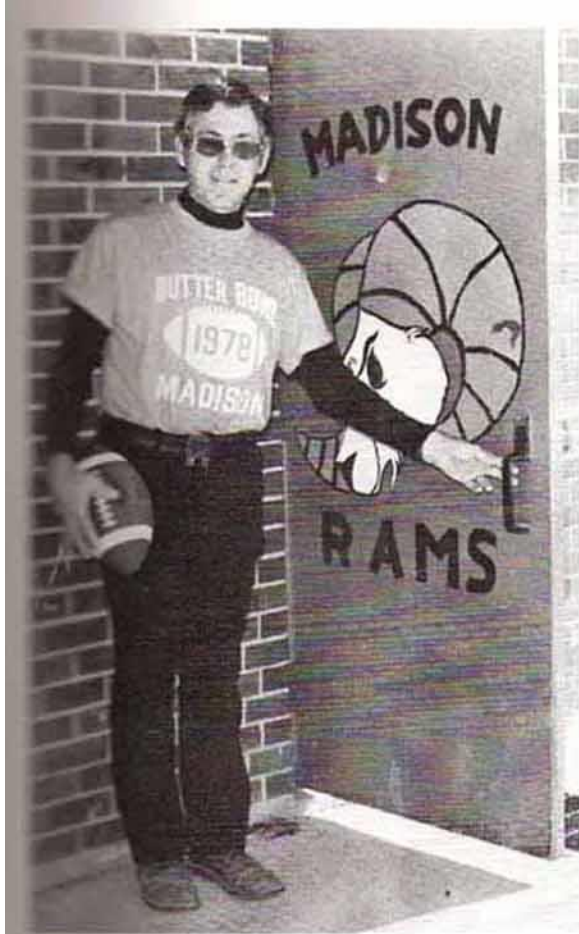
1978-79 Season One to be Remembered
