Another 9-2 season gave Coach Leech's Rams their third bowl appearance in his four years at M.H.S. in 1979.



Rams Roll to 21-6 Season

Coach Collier's boys' basketball team more than lived up to expectations in '79-80. Blitzing to eight wins in their first eight starts, the Rams then dropped five of their next eight contests, to East, Whites Creek, Maplewood, McGavock, and Maplewood again.

After that they became more consistent, whipping Hume-Fogg twice, Whites Creek and McGavock enroute to a regular season 21-6 record, including a third-place 9-5 district mark. All this in District 12-AAA, in all likelihood the toughest district in the state.


The Madison High School baseball team was even more successful than the more widely-acclaimed football and basketball squads.


