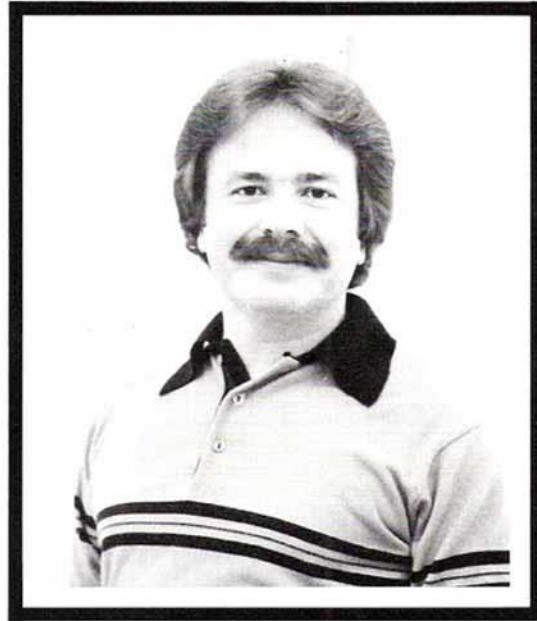
Madison Marching Rams Display Superior Ability
